## **Terms and Conditions of Enrolment**

- Holidays and Sickness If you take your child out of Nursery during term time, your child's fees must still be paid.
- Withdrawing a child from Nursery If you wish to withdraw your child from enrolment in Horspath Nursery, four weeks written notice must be given and all fees must be paid up to date. This includes children who are leaving to go to school.
- Supporting the Nursery The nursery is a charity and is dependent on fundraising to
  maintain and improve facilities and equipment. We ask all parents to participate in
  whatever way they can, for example attending committee meetings, helping at
  fundraising events or giving of their professional time/expertise with regards maintenance

## What happens next?

To join our waiting list we need your completed registration form together with a £35 deposit. (Children who are starting nursery in the term after their third birthday or later are entitled to 15 hours of government funded nursery time. If you are applying for these 15 hours alone, you do not need to pay the deposit.) If a deposit has been paid, your child will be given a gym bag and sweatshirt when they start nursery.

We will contact you when we allocate places, which is usually at least one term before the start of the academic year. We regret that we cannot guarantee before this time that a child will get a place. If we are unable to offer a place when we allocate places your deposit will be refunded. If, however, we offer you a place and you decide not to take it, we will not be able to refund the deposit. For full details please see our admissions policy which is available on our website. If in the meantime, you decide you no longer want a place, we would be very grateful if you could let us know so that you can be taken off the waiting list.
