The Nursery's process when we are informed of a potential Covid-19 concern:

1. Parents/staff members to inform the setting as soon as is reasonably possible.
2. The child or adult showing symptoms will be asked to self-isolate for 10 days or until the test result arrives.
3. If the test result is negative the child or adult can return to the setting.
4. If the test result comes back positive the Nursery may need to close and all children and staff will be asked to self-isolate for 10 days. The Nursery will be intensively cleaned during this time.
5. If you have been in contact with somebody who has covid, you will need to self-isolate for 10 days.

Please rest assured that we are trying our best to make sure that you and your family are kept safe during this troubling time.

Important Information

Just a few reminders about the way we are trying to keep as safe as possible during the current pandemic.

Parents will be asked to stand back from the black gate by the Nursery building on drop off and collection and you will be greeted by a member of staff to receive your children from the gate. If there are no adults when you arrive to collect your child, please ring the Nursery Number 01865 876750 and a member of staff will greet you. Please make sure that they have all their belongings with them on arrival. They will be asked to take their belongings into the cloakroom and to wash and sanitise their hands. We will take them to school as normal. (Children will not be able to access all toys due to the stringent cleaning procedures in place during this time.)

Please make sure that YOU keep to the 2m social distancing rules recommended by the government.

Please do not bring your child to the setting if you think that they could be unwell. If they need medication such as calpol, they need to stay at home. This also applies to any other family member.

If we think that your child is unwell, we will telephone you to collect them.

By sending your child/children to the setting, you are agreeing to the above terms.

Signs & Symptoms - High temperature, persistent cough, changes to taste.

Reminders to Parents

- **Parking – As you may be aware the police oversaw the parking at the end of the school day and were concerned about how parents park and obstruct others. Please could you make sure that you park safely at drop off and collection. Feedback from them was that children were running in the road and that they were worried about parents and children's safety.**
- Children aren't allowed on the adventure play ground before or after school hours.
- Please could you leave the school play area as quickly as possible at the end of the school day to enable us to start our clubs more efficiently.
- Please also ensure that the Nursery gates are kept bolted behind you.

- Due to present circumstances, we are not serving any food at breakfast club/After School club but children are welcome to bring in their own. **PLEASE NOTE THAT WE HAVE A NO NUT POLICY.**
- Due to the National Minimum Wage Increase, from September All Stars fees will be increased to £5.50 Breakfast Club and £9.00 for After School Club.
- Our current closing time is 5pm Monday-Friday. We will not be running the late session due to lack of demand.
- With restrictions lifting this isn't the time to become complacent, please make sure that you follow current Government Restrictions.

- We are now offering Arts & Crafts on Monday, Free Choice activities on Tuesday, Free Choice Crafts on Wednesday, Forest School on Thursday and Free Choice activities on Friday. (We are not able to access the school hall during the pandemic.)
- We offer Adhoc sessions but these spaces are limited so please book as early as possible to avoid disappointment.
- **The Last day Breakfast Club of Term 6 will be Wednesday 21st July and last day of After School Club will be Tuesday 20th July 2021. Thursday 22nd July is an Inset day.**
